Position Title: Webmaster

Purpose: The Webmaster maintains the existing LPNM website, troubleshoots problems, addresses hosting issues and plans for future expansion of the site.

Location: Virtual, anywhere in New Mexico

Key Responsibilities:

- Ensures the website complies with industry standards and best practices related to data security.
- Makes recommendations and implements plans to enhance search engine optimization.
- Maintains the website and troubleshoots any problems that arise.
- Addresses any problems or issues that may arise with hosting, domain name registration or any other item related to web management.
- Install analytics, monitor and report statistically relevant data.
- Maintain responsive web design.
- Plan future iterations of the website.
- Works closely with the Communications Committee regarding web content.
- Attends monthly Technology Committee meeting and makes reports on all items related to website management. (May attend virtually.)
- Work within a social contract of voluntary collaboration, respectful debate and mutual decision-making.
